Due to the ever increasing cost of things such as meals, shirts, badges, flyers, trophies, and the list goes on, the Committee has had to make the decision to raise the cost of the Poker Run for 2015.

In addition to rising costs, we Run but not pay for anything. would also like to be able to give SBH Qld more money

to help the kids who need it

The new costs are:

- Red Class (includes breakfast, dinner, camping, t-shirt & patch)-\$300
- Blue Class (includes & patch)-\$260
- Green Class (includes breakfast, camping, tshirt & patch)-\$220
- White Class (includes camping, t-shirt & patch)-\$150

for camping for everyone who camps, whether or not they themselves pay. The committee has decided that there will be a minimum price of \$150 for everyone who attends the Run and a system of identification for everyone who is camping.
