Pickled Galah - Maidenwell 30/12 – 1st Jan



Information of concerns relating to the VLAD Laws

- Failure to comply with search and questioning can result in the rider being arrested, at which point the new VLAD laws come into play and could mean a stay in jail for the rider while the wait for bail.
- There is no definitive list of associates and once on it there does not seem to be a way to get off it.

Things to remember

- YES you can record any conversation you are part of.
- NO. You don't have to tell police you are recording anything.
- If you are accused of being part of a criminal association and are not, dispute and advise police officer you are not
- Comply with police directions.
