Those wishing to ride with MacGyver to Petrie Park should meet at 126 Cambridge Street Granville before 10am. Map #1 below shows details on how to get to MacGyver's house.

Map #1



Cambridge Street is located approximately 7.6 km's from The Bruce Highway, Alice Street Turn Off.

Those travelling NORTH turn LEFT off highway and go RIGHT around roundabout onto Alice Street. Those travelling SOUTH turn LEFT onto Alice St from The Highway.

Follow Alice Street 5.6 km approx and turn RIGHT into March St.

Turn RIGHT at the end of March St into Kent Street.

Turn LEFT at The Granville Bridge. Cambridge Street is RIGHT at the lights after the bridge. 126 Cambridge St is on the LEFT side of the road.

Map #2 Petrie Park. Approximately 29km's from Cambridge Street Granville



Petrie Park is located just NORTH of Tiaro. Those travelling north should turn LEFT at Jacobsen St after passing through Tiaro. Those coming SOUTH should turn RIGHT into Jacobsen before entering Tiaro.

From Jacobsen go over Rail Bridge and turn RIGHT on Blackmount Rd, then first LEFT into Vandoom Rd.

Petrie Park is at the END of Vandoom Rd. Note: There is a steep decent into the park at the end of Vandoom
