#### Information of concerns relating to the VLAD Laws

- Failure to comply with search and questioning can result in the rider being arrested, at which point the new VLAD laws come into play and could mean a stay in jail for the rider while awaiting bail.
- There is no definitive list of associates and once on it, there does not seem to be a way to get off it.

#### Things to remember


- YES you can record any conversation you are a part of.
- NO. You don't have to tell police you are recording anything.
- If you are accused of being part of a criminal association and are not, dispute and advise police
- Comply with police directions.





# Easy on the riders

Bikers out to show they are the good guys

THE thunder of
Harley-Davidsons, Moto
Guzzis and Triumphs
rumbled through the
Maryborough CBD on a
Saturday morning as the
Independent Fraser Coast
Riders made their first
major charity run after the
group formed earlier this
year.

One of the organisers and founders of the social group, Michael Tucker, said although they wanted to continue charity work previously provided by social motorcycle groups, they also wanted to educate the public to show them that not everyone who rides a motorcycle is an outlaw.

He said the group didn't hold a high opinion of the new laws regarding motorcycle riders.

"It's potentially destructive for events such as this one here," he said.

"Politics kills a good thing.

"We're not out to cause trouble or mayhem.

"The idea behind the food drop to the Maryborough Animal Refuge was to have a simple, easy event that would include motorbikes and provide immediate good to a needy organisation within the area."

He said it was also for a whole lot of bikes to go on a short ride and show the public that not all

motorcycle riders are bad.

"Lately there has been such an emphasis on outlaw motorcycle groups, the government hasn't actually clearly identified what an outlaw motorcycle person looks like, so people like myself and Lizzie who ride motorbikes are now treated differently in the general community," Michael said.

He said he started riding motorbikes when he was 11 and has never been affiliated with an outlaw motorcycle gang.

"There is also a huge support network within the social motorbike fraternity that Queensland Health couldn't provide," he said.

The non-profit social bike group is planning on a

poker run in March, with the money raised going to spina bifida and the animal refuge.

The Independent Fraser Coast Riders have no hierarchy and value every member's opinion.

"People can do what they like, when they like. It's about enjoying the freedom and the social activities," Michael said.

"We did a bit of research over in the States to see if it was sustainable and it is — we find our biggest problem is when people say what your title is. We don't have one. There are bikies, bike riders and bike enthusiasts — we're all caught in the same net."


