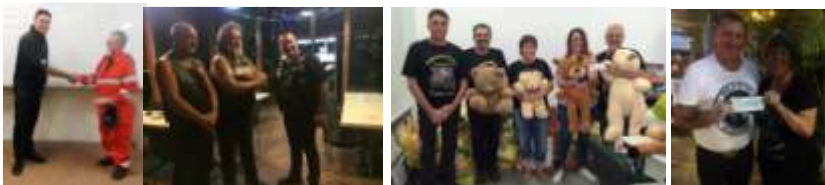

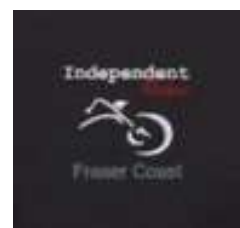

INDEPENDENT riders and affiliates reported an "excellent day" on Sunday, December 6, for the annual Fraser Coast Toy Run.

More than 300 two and three wheeled vehicles joined the procession, which departed Maryborough bound for Hervey Bay via Howard.

Organisers reported 340 registrations, but said more motorcycles joined the ride on the day, which made an impressive finish at the Hervey Bay Botanic Gardens.

Coordinator Michael Tucker said the event was huge and the response was overwhelming - in a good way.

Toys and cash have already been donated to Fraser Coast Family Network, of which the gifts will be wrapped and delivered to children on December 23.

The event raised \$8000, through a combined effort of the gold coin registration donation, a promotional stall at Station Square in Maryborough and sale of raffles and merchandise, plus a couple of cash donations from social bike groups and Richers Transport.

"We'd like to thank them, as well as business on the Fraser Coast which donated raffle items," Michael said.

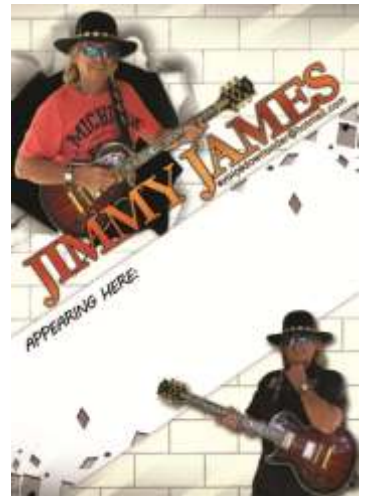

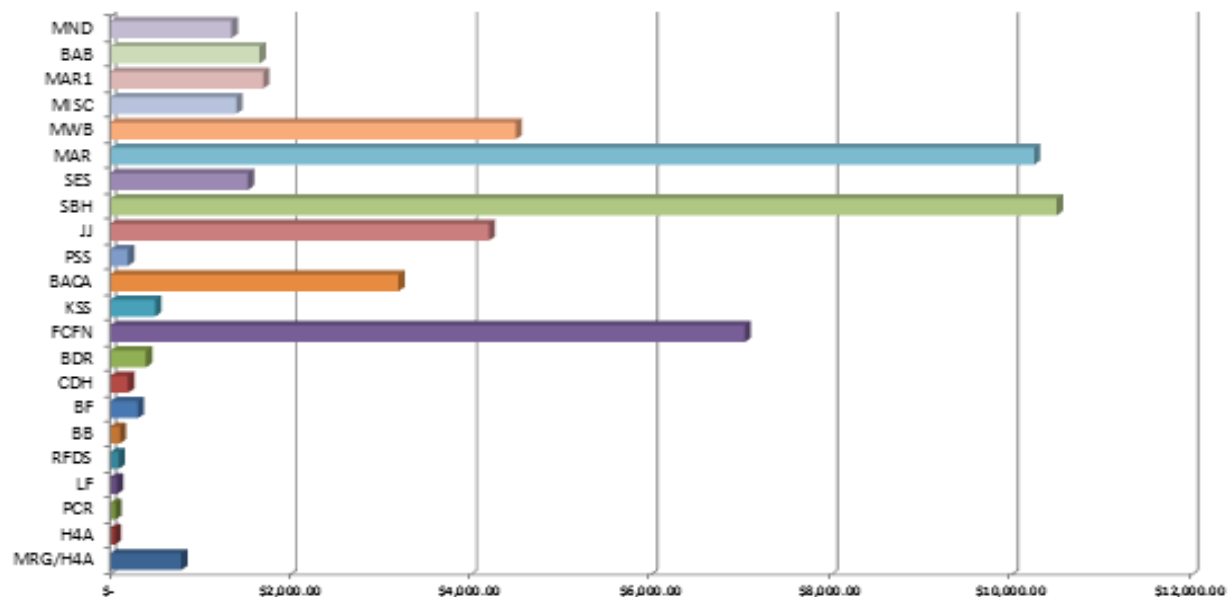
