While numbers were down money raised did help our farmers and was included in our Buy a Bale Scheme fundraising.








local charity group, riders travelled more Independent Riders Fraser Coast, has injected thousands of dollars of spending into rural Queensland communities and raised \$1200 for the Buy a Bale scheme to help support struggling farmers feed their livestock.

Around 30 members of the group rode out from Maryborough on Saturday, June 6, to Kilcoy where they met with members from their Brisbane branch.

Over three days the than 1000km around rural Queensland and visited famous watering holes like the Bun Hotel at Kaimkillembun and the Hivesville Hotel.

Michael Tucker from Independent Riders said the cash injection for rural communities was just as valuable as the money raised through raffles for the Buy a Bale Scheme.

"Our big focus is encouraging riders to spend money out in these regional and rural communities," he said.

"It is so worthwhile when you get to these towns and the residents are just so happy to see you and have your business.

"It made a few peoples' lives a little bit better."
