#### Independent Riders 2016 Fraser Coast Toy Run

The 2015 Fraser Coast Toy Run, exceeded our expectations as well as showed us where we can improve. The 2016 Fraser Coast Toy Run is scheduled for Sunday December the 4<sup>th</sup> 2016.

To improve on raffles and prizes our 2016 Toy Run will draw the raffles sold at Station Square on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Raffles on the day of the Toy Run will include cash and Visa (pre-paid cards), tickets for these will only be available on the day, to those who attend the event and will be drawn during our lunch stop.

In 2016 our lunch stop will also include live music being available during this period. As in previous years we will make changes to the route, to make it a little more interesting.

## Independent Riders Annual Poker Run 2016

- WHEN: Saturday March 12th 2016
- TIME: Registration from 7.00AM departing 9.30AM (Sharp)

This year's poker run will depart from Puma Service Station (South Maryborough) on the Bruce Highway, just south of Maryborough. The SES will be having a sausage sizzle there on the morning which will also include coffee.

This year's event is \$20.00 which includes your poker hand and an embroidered cloth patch. First prize (best hand), is 15% of registration proceeds to a maximum of \$500.00, 2nd is 10% to a maximum of \$150.00 and third 5% to a maximum of \$75.00

We will have giveaways as well as alcohol raffles at each pub stop

Route still needs to be confirmed 1st stop Gundiah, 2nd Goomeri, 3rd (Lunch) just out of Murgon at Tingoora Hotel, Last stop (Overnighter), Biggenden, with live music at the end with Jimmy James.

Meal prices, recipients, final details as well as mud maps will be available shortly.

## Three Day Pub Run 2016

This will be the third year we have run this event, with all proceeds going to The Buy a Bale Scheme, (supporting our farmers and the rural community)

This year's route is almost finalised with and will be advertised at the end of January. Like last year's event, Jimmy James will be coming along, providing entertainment for both nights.

This year we are asking for a \$10.00 registration fee which will include event embroidered patch with the balance going towards fuel for the support vehicle.

The event is three days with a total distance travelled, over that period around 1000 km and around 3-400km per day.. Camping, accommodation and meals will be organised for the event and prices detailed shortly.






