

LDAT WORKSHOPS

Sean's Update

G'day viewers, LDAT(Local Drug Action Team), is now in it's 5th week and is progressing well, if a 99% attendance rate is anything to go by. Three pushbikes are on the table at the moment, a beach bike that has just been painted a beautiful sky blue and is nearly ready for assembly, just waiting on some new parts to arrive, it will have white wall tyres, sprung seat, and a tool box, hand made by the students, in the 50s-60s style, mounted under the top rail, that really looks the part. Students have outdone themselves on this bike.

The second bicycle is a Schwinn Stingray that had severe damage from being in the weather, unused for several years. This bike has challenged the students with rust damage and dents but they have shone through, and it is almost ready for its final coat of anodised red and then some new parts and ready for re-assembly.

The third bicycle is a kit bike/chopper that just needed assembly but the students decided to give this one a custom paint job with orange and blue metallic paint, as it came from the factory as black. This bike comes equipped with engine mounts for a purpose built pushbike motor and long forks and low seat, cool looking pushy.

Students have already assembled a similar bike, with a motor, and a mild customisation job in orange and black, and has already been extensively tested up and down the driveway, to make sure its safe, of course, probably why they want to ride it every day, just to make sure its ok,.... and safe,.... and fun,... lots of fun

We were supposed to be starting a small engine course at the beginning but the mechanic we had lined up, fell ill, and we are hoping he is back on his feet after the school holidays.

Due to no small engine course being done, students have been doing MIG, Stick, and Oxy welding with volunteer boilermaker Paul, Tuesday and Wednesday. All students are progressing well and should be proud of what they are achieving. In the next few weeks, the students will be building a 1915 style replica motorcycle, perfect for the man cave, that should be ready for the wildlife sanctuary show and shine. All bicycles, and the replica, will be up for raffle at the show

Two of the students mothers have approached me now and said "What ever you're doing, keep doing it , he's a better child than ever and loving the course"....what can I say, we must be doing something right.







HELPING WITH CARE PACKAGES

What is a Care Package?

A care package is a parcel containing a variety of products that is sent to Australian Troops who are deployed overseas. These packages can contain a variety of products, some of which are listed below.

Funds raised and goods collected from our March 10 Poker Run went towards 60 care packages that were put together on March 24 and sent to our troops on the week ending 1 April 2018. Our plan is to continue collection of goods through 2018 until our poker run in 2019. Depending on goods collected we hope to send a further 20 care packages every couple of months during 2018/19 and a further 80 packages from proceeds of our 2019 Poker Run.

We currently have collection bins at Wilcox Bikes, Alice St Maryborough, Under the Gun Tattoos, Kent St Maryborough The Tinana Hotel Tinana and Fraser Coast Family Network Adelaide St Maryborough, with more added in Hervey Bay shortly. Goods and donations can be dropped off at these locations, products aren't expensive but will mean a lot to our troops.
