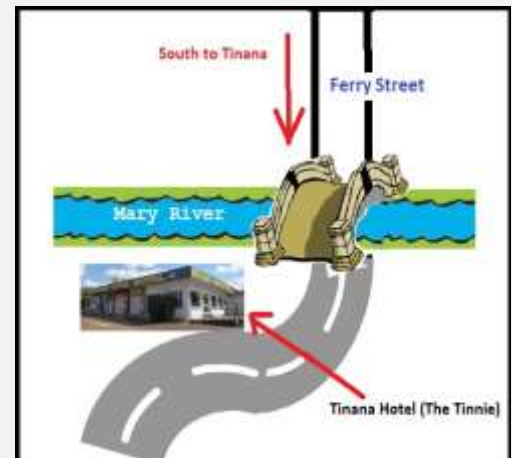

These two categories cannot work directly with Children or represent M.A.C.E. without a full member being present

## What is a Care Package?

Goods and donations can be dropped off at these locations, products aren't expensive but will mean a lot to our troops.
