


WE ARE LOOKING FOR SPONSORS

What is a Care Package?

A care package is a parcel containing a variety of products that is sent to Australian Troops who are deployed overseas. These packages can contain a variety of products, some of which are listed below.

Our plan is to continue collection of goods through 2018 until our poker run in 2020. In 2022 we would like to continue to support those that defended our countries beliefs.

GOSSIP/RUMOUR

circulating story or report of uncertain or doubtful truth information, often a mixture of truth and untruth, passed <u>around</u>

A rumour, is "a tall tale of explanations of events circulating from person to person and pertaining to an object, event, or issue in public concern." In the social sciences, a rumour involves a form of a statement whose veracity is not quickly or ever confirmed.

GOSSIPER/RUMOUR MONGER

A person who habitually reveals personal or sensational facts about others.

Gossipers are desperate and immature people. Jhey need drama, love conflict and are so deeply unconfident they feel compelled to tell and spread false accusations and stories about others in order to feel a sense of superiority, or to be able to play the ultimate role of the victim
